Mask Policy

Effective July 7, 2020

*Updates to this policy will be made as needed.

By Order of Governor Jim Justice of West Virginia, all members are required to wear a mask when they enter the YMCA facilities.

Occupants must keep the mask on until they reach specific destinations in the building. Specific rules for mask wearing will then apply depending on where you are located and what you are doing. Please also wear the mask as you are walking out of the building until you are outside the facility.

Fitness Center and Weight Room

Masks are NOT required if you are exercising AND you are maintaining 6 feet social distance from others. If you stop your exercise routine to talk to other people you must put on a mask. Social distancing is most challenging in the weight room so please be considerate of other members.

Locker Rooms

Masks are not required if you are changing clothes or walking to shower or steam room areas. If you stop to talk to other members and cannot maintain proper social distance, you are required to wear a mask.

Personal Training Areas

Staff members will wear masks, but members are not required to wear masks while exercising.

Group Fitness Areas

Staff members and members are required to social distance, but they members are not required to wear masks while exercising. If members stop to talk to other members before or after class, they should put on a mask or face covering.

Walking Track

The walking track is narrow so you must wear a mask if you are passing others or getting within six feet of others on the track.

A reminder for all members:

If you have concerns when you are in the building, please do not confront other members. Please address your concerns to staff members on duty. Please keep a mask with you at all times in case social distancing is not possible.
